Here is what we achieved in 2010:

- -We implemented 8 customised residencies for local and international artists from Australia, Singapore, Canada, Germany and Italy.
- -We partnered with 6 New York based organizations to implement 8 residencies across the city.
- -RU's artists in residency participated in 4 curated projects throughout the year, including the Missing Link organized by Martha Kirzenbaum in our new headquarters at 360 Court street in Brooklyn.
- -We facilitated 2 residency opportunities for New York based artists in Belo Horizonte (Brazil) and Pecs (Hungary).
