On Oct. 14, RU artist [David Helbich](#) will conduct a performative walk in New Jersey with the MFA Studio Art students. Furthermore, with [No Longer Empty](#), the 2015 class of [NLE Curatorial Lab](#) will come mid-October to our headquarters in Carroll Gardens for studio visits. Facilitated by NLE Associate Curator Rachel Gugelberger, The NLE Lab is a 15-week professional development program for emerging curators interested in gaining hands-on experience curating a site-specific exhibition.



This Fall, [Kristin Mclver](#) pursues her residency at RU. Starting Oct. 23 she will conduct 6 workshops with middle school students from M.S. 136, Charles O. Dewey. Under her guidance, they will develop "[Part II: Selfie in Sound](#)." The students will translate their face recognition data into a combined abstract portrait, represented in this case as a hip-hop sound composition.
