#### RU Talk: Curating Queer Black Legacies: Ajamu and Sur Rodney (Sur) in conversation




Ajamu, RU/Visual AIDS' fourth annual curatorial resident

# RU Talk: Knock, knock./Who's there?/Adore./Adore who?/ Adore is between us. Open up!




March 29, 6:30pm Residency Unlimited
