To begin with, New York City based artists are invited to apply to our 3rd annual **open call** for a 6 month residency at **Atelier Mondial** in Basel (CH) made possible through RU's exchange **partnership**.

This month, we enthusiastically welcome 3 NEA "Art Works Grant Program" grantees in our residency: **Brett Swenson**, **Keren Benbenisty** and **Liliya Lifanova** (all New York based). **Heather Dewey Hagborg** (Philadelphia) begins her triple residency with RU, Thoughtworks and Data and Society. In addition, **Diogo Pimentao** joins us from Portugal/UK, **Leasho Johnson** from Jamaica, and **Peter Puklus**, Hungary.


## **RU ALUMNI NEWS**
