Activity in August continues at an exciting pace with new collaborations underway. RU and Liquitex are delighted to announce that the US based artists Daniel Mantilla and Kristy Hughes have been selected for the fully funded Liquitex Cadmium-Free Research Residencies at RU. They will both work from a studio sponsored by Liquitex for 6 weeks and are invited to use a newly developed Cadmium-Free paint and other Liquitex materials of their choice. Invited from a shortlist suggested by RU, Mantilla begins his residency on August 1st. Hughes who was selected from an open call launched by Liquitex, starts on September 18.

We are honored to participate in the commencement of the **NYC Safe Haven Prototype**, a multi-organizational artist residency designed to house, integrate, and nurture artists at risk including those who are persecuted on the basis of their political affiliations, ethnic, geographic, religious, and/or gender-based persecution. Together with **ArtistSafety.net**, **Artistic Freedom Initiative**, and **Westbeth Artists Housing**, RU is hosting the residency of the Iranian artist and activist **Hadi Nasiri** starting August 1st.

This month, our incoming and fabulous roster of local and international artists includes: **Mimi Cherono Ng'ok** (Kenya), winner of the inaugural **2017 Photo London Artproof Award**, **Eva Davidova** (NYC), whose residency is funded by an NEA/Artworks grant secured by RU, **Carolina Paz** (Brazil), **Andrew Nicholls** (Australia) and **Ada Van Hoorebeke** (Belgium).

We are proud to invite you on **August 4** at the opening of **On Illusions** at the Cuchitritos Gallery + Project Space. Curated by Jodi Waynberg, this two person

show features paintings by the RU artists **Naomi Okubo** and **Kuniyasu Sakaizawa**, both from Japan.
