

SHIFT: A Residency for Arts Workers by the Elizabeth Foundation for the Arts supports NYC-based artists who are also arts workers through a 6 month long cohort-focused dedicated residency program focused on professional development and creative practices, while advocating for artists as arts workers in the field. Residents will receive a \$1,000 honorarium and more. **Deadline July 25.**



Residencies by Franconia Sculpture Park are open for application, including an Artist Family Residency for parents with children ages 8–18. All provide stipends of varying amounts, among other benefits. FSP is encouraging applicants with an interest in the intersection of art and ecology. **Deadline August 1.**

Art-in-Ed Workspace Residency by Women's Studio Workshop is open for application for artists who are interested in working with local students while creating their own work. Applicants must be able to teach intaglio, silkscreen, or hand papermaking. Deadline August 1.



14x48 is an open call request for proposals organized by **Shandanken** to artists of all career levels preferably living in New York City to exhibit an artwork on a billboard in New York City. Billboards will be posted early fall 2021 through winter 2022. Selected participants will receive a \$1,000 honorarium and production budget. **Deadline August 9.**
