**Your donation** validates our efforts in 2021 and helps us prepare for 2022.


I am so proud of the **Residency Unlimited** (RU) team and its commitment this past year in serving the resident artists, curators and creators with the highest standards possible, working around daily pandemic related conundrums with good humor and patience. In 2021, we hosted residencies for 36 artists and 11 curators, organized **12 exhibitions and 22 public programs** highlighting artistic practices from New York, Kentucky, Cuba, Slovenia, Japan, Mexico, Montenegro, Brazil, Croatia, Slovakia, Albania, Hungary, Norway, Dominican Republic, Georgia (Republic).

Integrating key issues of gaps in representation in residencies remains a priority. Programmatic high points in 2021 include the exhibition **Storying** generously hosted by the Andrew Freedman Home with projects by four local artists examining prison abolition, Black liberation activist archives and the largest slave auction in the history of the United States. Through our continued collaboration with the **NYC Health + Hospitals’ Arts in Medicine Program**, nine artists were selected to engage patients, staff, and local community residents to create integrated murals at NYC Health + Hospitals facilities.
