Request for Qualifications: 2022-2023 Lead Artists for NYC Health + Hospitals Arts in Medicine Community Murals Project

The Arts in Medicine department at NYC Health + Hospitals, with support from the Laurie M. Tisch Illumination Fund, is pleased to announce an open call in 2022 for 10 community murals that will be realized in 2023. Project period will occur from February 16 through December 1, 2023. Ten (10) professional visual artists will be selected to engage with patients, staff, and local residents to create an integrated internal or external mural at selected NYC Health + Hospitals facilities.

The Project Budget is \$10,000 per location for artist fees including design services,

community engagement, site preparation, fabrication, travel, and participation in installation. Any necessary supplies, permits, insurance, and documentation will be provided.

Bernheim's 2023 Artist in Nature Residence Program

Deadline: November 28, 2022

Each year up to 4 artists are selected for residencies at Bernheim. Includes \$2,500 stipend, housing, studio space, and financial and staff support for the development of new work. Artists will create a site-inspired artwork, temporary installation or project as a donation to the Bernheim Foundation.

EFA Studio Program: New Membership Application

Deadline: December 1, 2022

Selected artists are awarded two years of studio membership at EFA Center at 323 West 39th Street, with a move-in starting May 2023. Members receive a private studio that is subsidized at below market cost. Membership fees, ranging from \$634 to \$2022 per month, vary according to the size and shape of the studio assigned to the artist and the artist's demonstrated financial need.

2023 Socrates Annual Fellowship

Deadline: December 4, 2022

Fellowship recipients will receive a \$8,000 production grant, a \$2,000 honorarium, access to the facilities of the Park's outdoor artist studio, and an opportunity to present public artwork for the fall 2023 group exhibition. Fellowship will take place between May - September 2023.
