The Arts in Medicine department at NYC Health + Hospitals, with support from the Laurie M. Tisch Illumination Fund, is pleased to announce an open call in 2022 for 10 community murals that will be realized in 2023. Project period will occur from **February 27 - December 15, 2023**. Ten (10) professional visual artists will be selected to engage with patients, staff, and local residents to create an integrated internal or external mural at selected NYC Health + Hospitals facilities.

We are excited to add a new opportunity for immersive art that harness technologies such as VR, holography, and digital projection. The Community Mural Project is seeking these kinds of artists for places such as emergency room waiting areas, behavioral health, lobby's and pediatric spaces.

The Project Budget is \$10,000 per location for artist fees including design services, community engagement, site preparation, fabrication, travel, and participation in installation. Any necessary supplies, permits, insurance, and documentation will be provided.

Dedicated to artists who are traditionally underrepresented in the arts, RU's NYC-Based Artist Residency Program is accepting applications from artists who identify as Black, Indigenous and People of Color, with research-based practices that bridge gaps in historical knowledge. Four artists will be selected for a three-month residency, taking place from **April 3 - June 30, 2023**.

Criteria:

- RU welcomes applications from BIPOC artists working across media
- Artists have a research-based practice that bridges gaps in historical knowledge
- Artists live in one of the five boroughs
- The artist has a valid social security number
- Matriculated students are not eligible
- Please note that this program does not offer studio space

The 2023 NYC-Based Artist Residency features:

- \$3,300 stipend
- \$500 production support
- Weekly one-on-one visits with guest curators/critics, including meetings with guest curator **Rachel Raphaela Gugelberger**, the RU team and invited art professionals
- Activities with international artist resident community including artist presentations,

- a monthly salon and field trips
- Project/production assistance
 - A culminating group exhibition at [PS122 Gallery](#) in the East Village, June 5 - June 27, 2023
